

# Sorcerer's Apprentice

This easy scarf is made of one skein of sock yarn and consists of knit and purl stitches. I used the supersmooth Cashmere-blend yarn from the Zauberwiese online shop . That guarantees a beautiful drape and a soft hand. Nevertheless you can use any kind of yarn. With a yardage of 420m/100 g the scarf will have a size of 150x25cm (60''x10'') .A nice size, which can be worn in many different ways!



**Material:** 100g Kaschmir, a blend yarn from the Zauberwiese shop, needles Nr. 3(US2.5)

**Directions:** CO 63 stitches (Number of stitches must be divisible by 3 plus 3 stitches)

**RS:** k across

**WS:** \*k3,p3\*, to the last 3 stitches, k3

Repeat these 2 rows until yarn is finished or desired length is reached.
